TICKETS

At the airport Metro station vending machines:

1. Buy Public transport card “Tarjeta Multi” (2,5€)
2. Charge it with 10 tickets deal (7,30€)
3. Add airport supplement (3€)*

*Airport supplement is not covered



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TRANSPORT

FROM AIRPORT TO HOSTEL:

1. From the airport, take **Metro Line 8** towards Nuevos Ministerios station.
2. Once in Nuevos Ministerios take Cercanias **C3** towards Aranjuez or **C4** towards Parla and hop off at Sol station.
3. Walk 4 minutes to get to the Hostel.

💡 Alternative: You can also check real-time availability and alternative routes on Google Maps by entering **Onefam Sungate Hostel's** address.



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TRANSPORT

FROM HOSTEL to VENUE:

1. From the Hostel, walk 3 minutes towards Sol station.
2. Once there, take **Metro Line 1** towards Pinar de Chamartin and hop off at Plaza de Castilla station.
3. From Plaza de Castilla Walk 10 minutes to get to the venue, the Coworking Espacio Geranios.

More info – Schedules

All the metro lines are available with variatin frequencies from 6:05am to 2am. This schedule does not change on weekdays or weekends.

But **watch out!** The last service starts at 1:30am from the end of the line, so you should check the time at which it will go through your desired station!

Useful apps for moving around in Madrid are Google Maps, Moovit and Metro de Madrid, which you can find in Google Play and in the App Store.

*Please take care of your personal belongings in the Metro. It is not frequently that things get stolen, but let's not take chances!



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More info – Alternatives to public transport

Besides public transport there is Taxi and VTC options (Uber, Cabify, Bolt).

Regarding prices, a Taxi from the airport to the city center costs 30€ (fixed price) for VTC options it depends on demand but it is usually between 15€ and 25€.

- Lake Boats (3–6€).



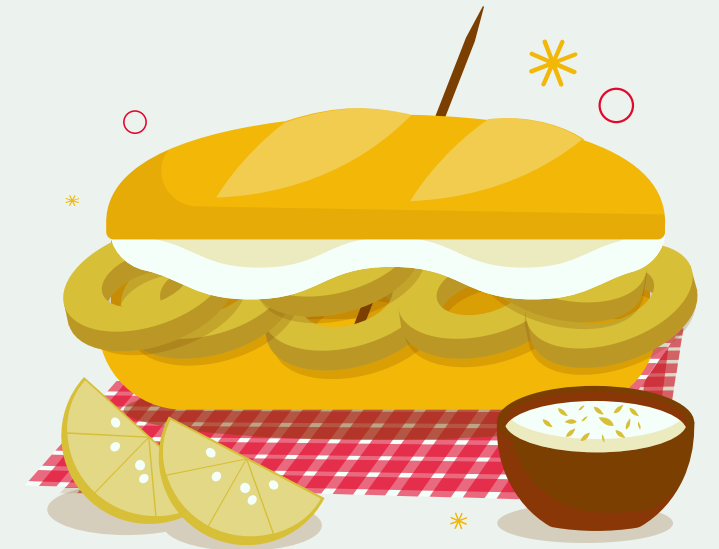
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PROPOSED INTERCULTURAL ACTIVITIES AFTER TRAINING:
